DECREE OF DIVORCE

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The above matter having come on for hearing before the Court on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of November, 1992, and at said hearing, the Plaintiff and his attorney, Stanley E. Whiting, having appeared in person, and the Defendant and her attorney, Kathleen Trandahl, having appeared in person, and the court having heard testimony, and it appearing that more than sixty (60) days have elapsed since the date of said personal service of the summons and complaint upon the Defendant, and the Court having entered its Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and being fully advised of the premises therein:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that each party shall be awarded an absolute decree of divorce from the other party on the grounds of irreconcilable differences.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Plaintiff shall have the care, custody and control of the minor children; to-wit: Heather Lynn Frederick and Wayne William Frederick, subject to reasonable and liberal visitation on behalf of the Defendant.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Defendant shall pay child support through the Clerk of Court's Office in Rosebud, South Dakota on behalf of the minor children commencing in November of 1992 in the amount of \$382.00 per month for both of said children through June of 1993 and commencing in July of 1993 in the amount of \$244.00 per month for the minor child, Wayne William Frederick, until such time as the child reaches his eighteenth birthday but if said child is still in high school, then until the child graduates from high school but not beyond the child's nineteenth birth.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Defendant shall carry medical insurance on the minor children of the parties and Plaintiff shall pay 5% of said medical insurance and 5% of any unreimbursed medical expenses. Defendant shall pay 45% of the medical insurance on the minor children and 45% of any unreimbursed medical expenses for the minor children.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant shall show proof of the medical insurance premium on the minor children and Defendant shall credit the Plaintiff's 5% share of the medical insurance premiums on the minor children directly from the child support.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the property and debts of the parties herein shall be divided as set out in the Findings of Facts.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the parties shall alternate the children as income tax deductions as set out in the Findings of Facts.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that each party shall be responsible for payment of their own attorney fees.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant may have her maiden name of Wright restored to her.


